















STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM 2018-2019

The concised results are as follows:







SUMMARY OF PROFESSIONAL FEEDBACK REPORT 2018-2019

We have taken feedback about curriculum from experts in the profession. Total 7 professionals gave their expert suggestions and feedback. In terms of the design of curriculum, around 42.8 % felt that design of syllabi is sufficient in terms of global development in education and technology. Where as other 57.2 % said that it is not sufficient. A slight part 28.6 % said 'yes' with the idea that B.Sc. Nursing curriculum enable a student to understand gaps in nursing career where as a vast majority 71.4% still felt that it is not helpful. The concept of Nursing course covers all human care needs of modern life , a few majority, 42.8 % had the opinion that it can but; a major part 57.2% felt cannot be the same syllabi.

In relation to the current teaching pattern and examination, 42.8 % felt that it focus on learner's view on the nursing career; where as 57.8.% have not the same but opposite idea. The idea of Syllabus and curriculum provide adequate options for short courses that focus future nursing career, a vast majority 71.4% said it provides where as few part 28.6 % said it don't. To the statement; the core curriculum enable a student to be independent and manage all types of patients : a vast majority; 85.7% agreed it do, where as low part- 14.3% said it don't.

To the concept that students examination results reflect their skills in nursing; 57.2% has the opinion that it it can, where as 42.8 % said it may not be. The idea of the practical and theory syllabus (INC/MPMSU) balance in view of skill requirement in modern nursing, the reaction showed that 42.8% with yes where as others 57.2 % opined it not balances.

The results reveal that it is the time to review the syllabus .

In terms of open ended queries, mixed opinions and suggestions received.

Even then overall score with minimum poll showed that curriculum revision is required from time to time.
