SUMMARY OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK 2021-2022

About teachers explanation on course outcome and 99 students rated as satisfactory and 87 said it was very satisfactory. 79 students are very much satisfied with the teaching learning activity in the institution. 90 students rated satisfactory and 80 students rated very satisfactory regarding teachers approach towards teaching. 102 students responded very satisfactory where as 82 students satisfied about institution makes effort to engage students in monitoring, review and quality improvement. 92 students responded very satisfactory and 79 satisfactory about the student centric method. 91 were very satisfied and 70 responded satisfactory about the teaching and mentoring process in cognitive, social and emotional growth. 71 said very satisfactory and 70 satisfactory about sharing of answer of class test and discussion of student's performance in classroom by teachers. 94 responded very satisfactory, 73 satisfactory regarding problem solving and doubt clearing by the teachers during teaching learning in classroom. 83 students were very satisfactory and 82 satisfactory about fairness in the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 87 responded very satisfactory and 81 satisfactory regarding institute encourage and motivates the students for classroom participation. 85 students said very satisfactory regarding teachers' concepts using example and application. 85 were satisfied about clarity in teachers communication. 86 students responded very satisfactory and 71 satisfactory regarding teachers identifies the strength of the students and help to face physical, emotional, and learning challenges at right level. Helps students irrespective of gender 97 students responded very satisfactory and 69 satisfactory. Regarding enhancing student's capacity and talents by providing opportunity in participating in various Intercollegiate events (sports, yoga, dance, music, painting, drawing etc.) 89 were very satisfactory and 78 responded outstanding. 92 said very satisfactory about the opportunities in participating outreach & social programs. 97 students responded very satisfactory about the institute/ teachers make efforts to delegate responsibilities and inculcate soft skills, life skills, employability skills to make students ready for leadership opportunities. 84 students were very satisfied about the adequacy of furniture in classroom. 96 students responded outstanding and 75 very satisfactory about security arrangement in college (CCTV, Closed coverage campus). Orientation and guidelines for safety and security 93 students mentioned very satisfactory and 66 outstanding. 89 students were very satisfactory about first aid facility in college. Regarding cleanliness and hygiene in classroom 83 responded very satisfactory and 76 outstanding. 85 students were very satisfied about the toilet and washroom hygiene. 88 responded very satisfactory and 68 outstanding about R.O drinking water facility with water cooler. Transport facility for field trip 87 students said outstanding & 84 were very satisfied. 86 students said very satisfied regarding access to college library. 90 responded satisfactory and very satisfactory about provision of counselling.

Adequate number of stimulators and model 103 responded very satisfactory. 99 students were very satisfied and 59 satisfied that individual students get exposed to the labs. Adequate number of supplies i.e article, instruments etc 86 students were very satisfactory and 74 students were satisfactory. 101 students were very satisfied and 60 responded outstanding about the supervision by teachers during lab hours. SUMMARY OF T FACULTY FEEBACK 2021-2022

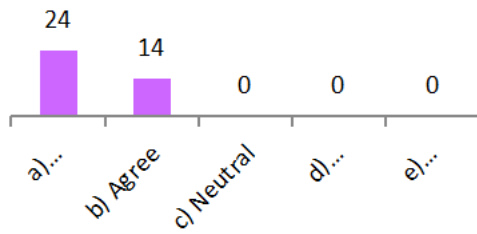

In relation to system followed by the institute for design and development of curriculum, 9 (60%) strongly agreed that it is effective. 8 (53.3%) of them agreed that department level subject expert committee meeting occurs to review the syllabus . 9 (60%) agreed that job assignments and workload are distributed fairly. 13 (86.7%) of them agreed that aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to students. 11(73.3%) agreed that theory syllabus completion occurs (90%-100%) in INC prescribed hours. 8(53.3%) of them strongly agreed that clinical exposure and practical experience of students completed in INC prescribed hours. 12(80%) of them agreed that curriculum incorporates recent technological development in the area. SUMMARY OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT ON CURRICULUM

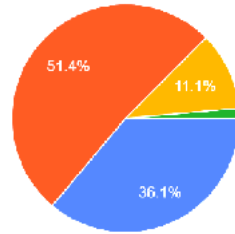

SUMMARY OF EMPLOYER FEEDBACK

9. Out of total responses, 100% alumni are good in continuous improvement in their working area.

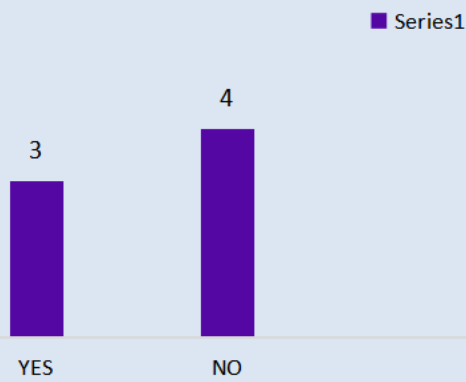

SUMMARY OF PROFESSIONAL FEEDBACK REPORT 2021-2022

We have taken feedback about curriculum from experts in the profession. Total 7 professionals gave their expert suggestions and feedback. In terms of the design of curriculum, only 42.8% felt that design of syllabi is sufficient in terms of global development in education and technology. Where as other 57.2% said that it is not sufficient. Around 57.2% were ok with the idea that B.Sc. Nursing curriculum enable a student to understand gaps in nursing career where as majority: 42.8% has the opposite idea. The concept of Nursing course covers all human care needs of modern life , a majority, 71.4% had the opinion that it can but a few that is 28.6% cannot be the same syllabi. In relation to the current teaching pattern and examination, 71.4% felt that it focus on learner's view on the nursing career; where as 28.6% have not the same but opposite idea. The idea of Syllabus and curriculum provide adequate options for short courses that focus future nursing career, around 71.4% said it provides where as 28.6% said it don't. To the statement; the core curriculum enable a student to be independent and manage all types of patients : 71.4% agreed it do, where as low majority-28.6% said it don't. To the concept that students examination results reflect their skills in nursing; 57.2% has the opinion that it it can, where as 42.8% said it may not be. The idea of the practical and theory syllabus (INC/MPMSU) balance in view of skill requirement in modern nursing, the reaction showed that vast majority of 71.4% with yes where as others -42.8 % opined it not balances. The results reveal that it is the time to review the syllabus .In terms of open ended queries, mixed opinions and suggestions received. Even then overall score with minimum poll showed that curriculum revision is required from time to time.
