

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

HOSPITAL BASED CANCER REGISTRIES-DATA MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE UNDER NATIONAL CENTRE FOR DISEASE INFORMATICS AND RESEARCH, Bengaluru (INDIAN COUNCIL OF MEDICAL RESEARCH)

National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research (NCDIR), Bengaluru commenced in 2011 as an evolution of the National Cancer Registry Programme (NCRP) to develop and sustain a national research database on cancer, diabetes, CVD and stroke through recent advances in electronic information technology with a national collaborative network, so as to undertake aetiological, epidemiological, clinical and control research in these areas. For details, please visit www.ncdirindia.org

NCRP was commenced by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) with a network of cancer registries across the country in December 1981. The main objectives of this Programme are:

1. To generate reliable data on the magnitude and patterns of cancer
2. Undertake epidemiological studies based on results of registry data
3. Help in designing, planning, monitoring and evaluation of cancer control.
4. Develop training programmes in cancer registration and epidemiology.

Over the years the NCRP Coordinating Unit at Bengaluru, has become a beehive of IT enabled software programme development. This includes development of several web based modules for the first time anywhere which are user friendly.

The data from cancer registries can be used for cancer control as well as for research purposes. The data from population based cancer registries, is useful in defining the magnitude and commonly affected sites of cancer. This helps in planning the quantum and type of preparedness for health services for combating the disease. The changes in incidence rates also provide a parameter for evaluation of the impact of intervention programs or socio-cultural changes. Changes in proportion of stages of disease at which the patients first contact health services (from population or hospital based cancer registries) may also be a useful parameter for such changes. The data from hospital based cancer registries helps in assessing the survival of cancer patients in relation to anatomical site, clinical stage, different treatment modalities, etc. The database may provide clues for generation of hypothesis regarding etiology and to carry out research studies.

The basic methodology for Hospital Based Cancer Registry Database Management software envisages capturing core patient information including permanent residential address of all cancers reported / registered in your institution. The data so accrued would essentially aim in fulfilling the following broad objectives of the Hospital Based Cancer Registries (HBCRs) for all anatomical sites of cancer and Patterns of Care and Survival (POCSS) in cancer cervix, cancer breast and head & neck.

- > Assess Patient Care;
- > Participate in Clinical Research on patient management;
- > Provide the patterns of cancer in the identified sites in your participating centres;
- > Help plan hospital facilities;
- > Contribute to active follow-up of the cancer patient;



- Describe length and quality of survival in relation to anatomical site, clinical stage and aspects of types of treatment;
- Undertake relevant clinical and epidemiological research;
- Document time trends in proportion of early to late stages at the time of diagnosis;
- Help assess quality of hospital care and cancer services.
- To strengthen population based cancer registration in your area, if applicable.

Agreement for co-operation in the performance of work on "Hospital Based Cancer Registries-Data Management (HBCRDM) Software, under National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research, Bengaluru" between Mrs. F S Roselind, Scientist D, Indian Council for Medical Research(ICMR) - National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research(NCDIR), Bengaluru on behalf of Director, ICMR-NCDIR, hereinafter called Principal Investigator (PI) and Principal Investigator of the participating centre(C-PI) Dr.Sunil Chandiwal, Director Medical Services, Choithram Hospital & Research Center, Indore M.P.

The total duration of the project is five years and it is effective from 1st March 2017. The funds will be released on annual basis.

The C-PI is responsible for the following.

1. Collection, collation and transmission of data of all malignant neoplasms reported from the above centre from the year 2017 onwards.
2. Follow terms and conditions (attached), which are necessary for uniformity and successful execution of HBCRDM.

In consideration of the above, the budget will be released. The annual budget of Rs.6,94,060/- is provided in the attached sheet.
